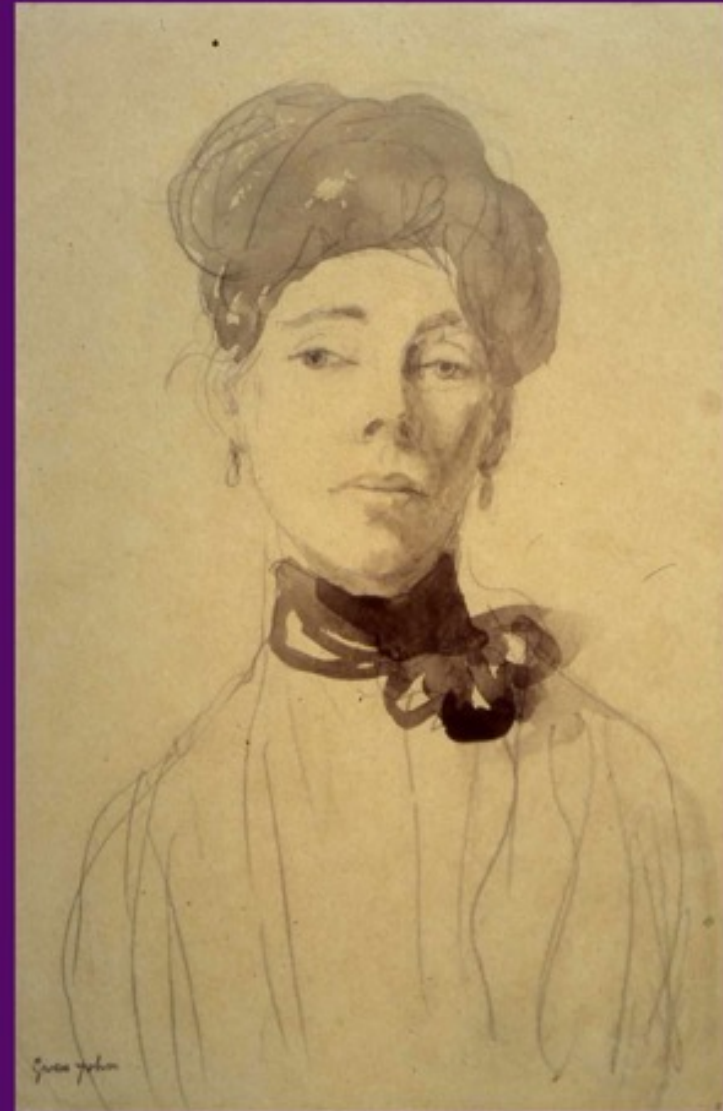

At that time, it was the only art school in the country where women could study! She was very talented, but because most artists at the time were men, she spent a lot of her life fighting to be noticed.

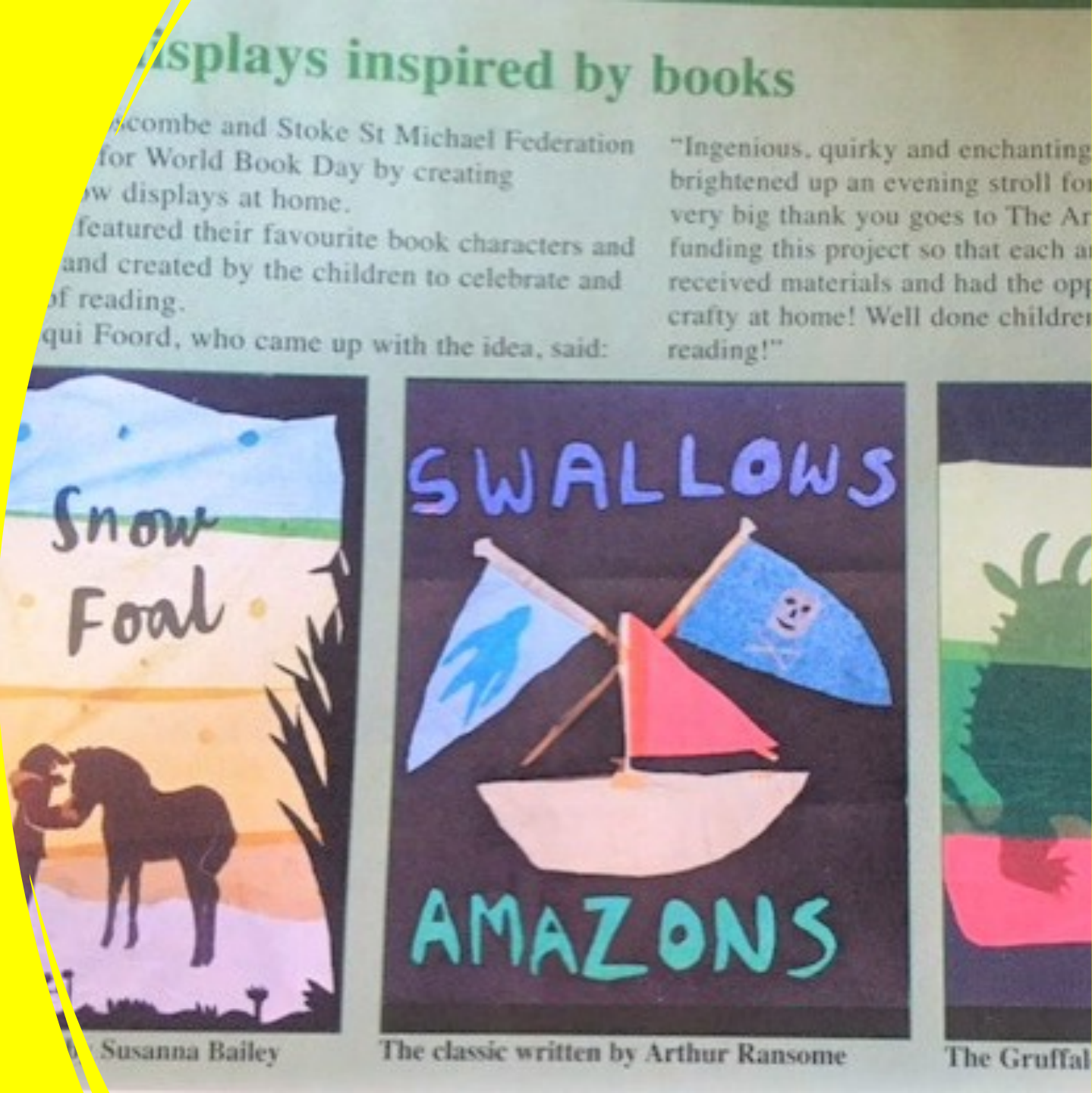
